Marriage in India, Thailand or other countries: - Original or true certified copy of marriage certificate duly certified by the Diplomatic representation in Colombo of the country where the marriage took place. - English Translation of the marriage certificate (if applicable) duly certified by the Consular Section of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs - " Certificat de capacité à mariage " issued by the relevant French Embassy or Consulate prior to the marriage (if any)		
	3.3. Original or True certified copy of the main applicant and each child's birth certificate duly certified by the Consular Section of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs		
	3.4. English Translation of the main applicant and each child's birth certificate duly certified by the Consular Section of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs

	6.1. Parental consent of the parent staying in Sri Lanka, certified by an attorney-at-law <i>If both parents are in France: the parental consent must be legalised at the French townhall and a copy of their residency card must be provided</i>		
	6.2. if one parent is missing: certificate of absence or death certificate or court order stating there is no objection on the child migrating to France, duly certified by the Consular Section of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs
